

Gateway Preventive Maintenance Guide

This guide outlines the essential daily, weekly, monthly, and semi-annual maintenance tasks to ensure optimal equipment performance and longevity.

Daily Maintenance Tasks

- Empty hopper and tank, ensure gates are dry and free of debris using the clean-out cycle.
 - Check fluid levels.
 - Visually look for loose hardware, worn components, product build-up, and the presence of all safety labels.

Weekly Maintenance Tasks

- Rinse and cycle the hopper and clean the spreader disk.
 - Rinse the unit and blow dry.
 - Flush the tank and clean the strainer.
 - Check electrical connections for corrosion.
 - Ensure front wheels are aligned straight.
 - Check the traction cable for damage or wear.
 - Check that the ball stud is stationary.
 - Ensure steering linkages are tight.
 - Ensure tires are properly inflated and in good condition.
 - Ensure the parking brake is properly adjusted.

Monthly Maintenance Tasks

- Grease all fittings.
 - Inspect and recalibrate tips.
 - Inspect and recalibrate gates.

Semi-Annual Maintenance Tasks

- Flush fluids and replace filters.
 - Winterize unit before freezing temperatures.
